- Groundwater high in minerals give this town its name. In the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries, visitors flocked to Mineral Wells to avail themselves of these “healing” waters
- In the 1910s and 1920s, Mineral Wells hosted spring training camps for baseball teams, including Chicago White Sox, Cincinnati Reds and St. Louis Cardinals
