Texas A&M Forest Service, Texas Forestry Association and the Texas Chapter of the International Society of Arboriculture.

Texas A&M Forest Service wants to partner with your organization to celebrate Texas Arbor Day in your city. We will bring foresters and media exposure to your community and the Texas State Forester will emcee your event. We will also invite the Texas Governor and area legislators.

Applying to host the event is easy.

1. Fill out the application.
2. The Texas Arbor Day selection committee will consider the qualifications and unique characteristics of your organization and city.
3. The winning city will be notified by the selection committee.
