Did you know?

Fire safety is an important practice to keep forests and homes safe.

While Camping or Recreating...



Make sure fires are allowed in your area.

Keep your fire at least 10 feet from trees, buildings and tents



Keep your fire in a designated fire ring

Keep your fire downwind from your tent



Never leave a fire unattended

Make sure your fire is DEAD OUT!



For Homeowners...

Create a **Defensible Space** around your home!



Keep vegetation at least 10 feet from your home



Keep firewood and propane tanks at least 30 feet from your home

Prune lower branches of trees

Make sure your address is clearly labelled on your home
